The City will collect leaves from October 1st, 2016 through November 15th, 2016. Any remaining leaf piles will be collected through November 27th, 2016, if weather permits. If after these dates you still have leaves, you must bag them and take them to one of the Self Help Centers.

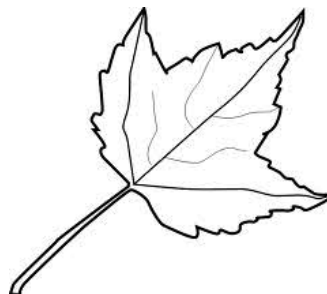
1) DO NOT to put Halloween pumpkins in leaf piles - put them in garbage cans.

2) DO NOT add brush to leaf pile - call for a special brush pickup at 414-276-2489.

3) DO rake leaves into the street - curb side, keeping the leaves clear of storm drains .

1, Dial 911 for all emergencies: life threatening situations, crimes in progress such as robbery, shots fired/shooting, prowling, battery.

2. Dial 933-4444 for non emergencies/not life threatening: loud music, loitering, problems in Enderis Park, suspected drug house, mobile drug dealing, suspicious person/auto.

press 9 - need an officer on the scene

press 2 - officer is NOT needed at the scene

press 8 - report a drug house and drug activities NOT in progress(can request to be anonymous)

3. What is a suspicious person?
going door to door, then going to back or side of house - could be casing to burglarize or burglary in progress
carrying property at unusual time or location- could be leaving scene of a burglary, robbery or theft

heavy human traffic at a residence on a daily or regular basis - indicative of vice, drug or fencing operations

4. What is a suspicious vehicle?
slow moving vehicles or if the course followed is aimless or repetitive - casing for places to rob or burglarize
certain parked and occupied vehicles seen at unusual times and places - could be look out for burglary or robbery
vehicles being loaded with valuables, especially if parked in front of closed business or unattended residence - could be burglary or theft

vehicles with tinted windows pulling up to another vehicle with an "exchange" - likely mobile drug deal.
Note date, time, location and license plate if possible

Tips to prevent crimes of opportunity:

Open windows - when not home or sleeping, either shut and lock windows or install "stoppers/pins" so that the window only opens 6 inches - thereby preventing screens from being cut for easy entry.

Open doors - lock doors at all times, even when working in the yard or shoveling snow- you could be in the front and if a back door is open, it only takes minutes for someone to enter and steal a purse, phone, electronic device etc. , especially if you live on an alley.

Lighting - leave porch and garage lights on all thru the night - a well-lit property deters crime.

Garage - install dead bolt locks and chain bikes, lawn mowers and snow blowers to the wall with an "eye" bolt. Close garage doors when not in sight of the garage door- another opportunity to steal bikes, equipment etc.

Auto theft - if you park on the street or in the alley, use a "Club", especially if you have an older model vehicle or a Dodge or Chrysler product. Stolen cars are often used for joy riding, then committing robberies in the stolen vehicles.
