### Enderis Park Playground Improvements

The children's playground in Enderis Park has not been modernized in many years and is somewhat antiquated. EPNA has decided to take the lead in changing this situation. If you attended last summer's concerts in the park, you may have noticed a display illustrating possible improvements to the playground area. You may even have filled out a survey indicating what type of improvements you would like to see.

EPNA is now ready to report on the progress made so far on the playground project. The survey results were tabulated and based upon them our consultants have drawn up an exciting plan for a completely new playground space. Both the City and MPS have been involved in the planning process to ensure that the proposed improvements meet their playground standards.

We now want to share the plan with you, our neighbors. On Saturday, January 9 we will be holding an open house in the park field house from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm. The first three hours of the open house coincide with Mulchfest. So after dropping off your Christmas tree, please take a few minutes to warm up in the field house and check out our hopes and dreams for a truly great children's playground.

Of course, even if you don't have a tree to drop off, you are invited to come by and see the playground

plans. Arrive any time during the open house hours and stay as long as you want. Refreshments will be available. The consultants who developed the plan will also be there to answer any questions you may have.

This is an exciting project for EPNA!

### West Burleigh/West Lisbon Commercial District

The West Burleigh/West Lisbon Commercial District from North 68th street to North 92nd street has, in recent years, undergone and continues to experience changes in ownership, businesses and "retail character." Businesses within the identified Burleigh and Lisbon corridors have been affected by factors including natural turnover (retirements), foreclosures, business moves, competition from retail centers in the area (Mayfair Mall, Downtown Wauwatosa, etc.) and retail trends such as online shopping.

Residents and business owners in the Enderis Park, Kopps Park, and Cooper Park neighborhoods, as well as the Mount Mary College area have expressed concerns over these trends. These groups have joined forces with the City of Milwaukee, together with the strong support and commitment from Alderman Bohl and Alderman Murphy to maintain neighborhood-serving businesses and create the most vibrant, appealing commercial district possible. An Advisory Group (Steering Committee) has been formed to guide the discovery process and subsequent decision-

making for the west Burleigh/ Lisbon commercial district strategy.

A survey was developed by the Department of City Development Planning (DCD) and Commercial Corridors staff and made available to all stakeholders during the fall of 2015. The purpose of the survey was to identify the current issues and concerns and perceived neighborhood needs. The results will assist the Advisory Committee in the development of strategy for the west Burleigh/ Lisbon commercial district that can be used by neighborhood groups, property owners and Real Estate Brokers. There were over 750 responses to the survey. The results were shared at an open community meeting on November 16, 2015 held at the Milwaukee School of Languages. Over 125 participants were present to hear the results of the survey. Aldermen Bohl and Murphy, and members of the DCD staff provided information and answered questions regarding the survey. The results provide very positive data regarding the surrounding communities of the west Burleigh/ Lisbon corridors, as well as defined directions for positive changes to support improvements in our local business community.

1. DCD will provide the survey results online (West Side Plan Website) to stakeholders.
2. Department of City Development (DCD) staff will conduct interviews to clarify and further define needs and

issues.

3. The Advisory Committee will meet to look at options for organizing and to implement

some of the key strategies that emerged from the survey.

4. Development of the Final Report and West Burleigh/West Lisbon Commercial Improvement Strategy/Plan

5. Distribute the Plan and Take Action.

Bringing your tree to the Enderis Park Fieldhouse helps keep your community green. Your tree will be turned into mulch which the City uses on its boulevards and parks. Bring a bag and you can haul the mulch from your tree home and use it in your yard in the spring. ## Shovel Your Sidewalk – It’s The Law

Remember that residential and commercial property owners and occupants are required to clear sidewalks abutting their property of snow or ice within 24 hours of a storm. If violations are reported, a 24 hour notice is issued. If the sidewalks still are not cleared, a sanitation crew will clear a path and put the charge on the property tax bill.

If you have older or disabled neighbors, please help them if you can.

Make our city safer by shoveling out the fire hydrants near your home. “Adopting” a fire hydrant will ensure maximum visibility for firefighters in the event of an emergency. To report an unshoveled sidewalk, call **286-2489**.

## Safety tips for the Holidays

**Leave lights on** - a well-lit home deters crime - leave on front porch lights and garage lights.

**Set timers** - when away, leave indoor lights, a radio or TV on or set a timer so the house looks and sounds occupied.

**Don't advertise** - don't display holiday gifts, electronics or flat screen TVs. Close drapes/curtains so as not to display big screen TVs.

**Be aware of surroundings** - crime tends to increase around the holidays as people carry more cash/credit cards. If you think you are being followed, don't enter your garage - keep driving. Also back into the garage for a better view of your surroundings.

**Running vehicles** - if you warm up your vehicle, be sure to lock it.

**Frequently stolen vehicles**- use

a CLUB on your vehicle if it is a 2006 older model and one of these makes: Chrysler: Town and Country, Sebring, Dodge: Caravan, Intrepid, Neon, Stratus, Jeep Cherokee, Plymouth Voyager, or 2001 older models of Honda: Accord and Civic.

## Winter Reminders

**Night parking** - park on the even and odd numbered address sides based on the date so snow plows can remove snow. Night parking starts at 11 PM

**Alleys** - snow must be removed from around the trash containers for access by sanitation workers. When shoveling in the alley, DO NOT push the snow into the alley- do not assume the plow will come through - this just makes it harder for everyone else to get through

**Xmas trees - take to Mulchfest!!**  
Or dispose by placing where your garbage is picked up - alley or curb - just like your garbage cans.
